The Australian International Health Institute (AIHI), an operational arm of the Nossal Institute for Global Health, in partnership with the Jamkhed Comprehensive Rural Health Project (CRHP), will be running **two** short courses at the Jamkhed Institute in Maharashtra State of India.

The courses are designed for medical, allied health, social work, nursing, development studies students and anyone who is keen to learn about health in resource poor settings.

Learn about the principles and practice of community-based primary health care at a program that is an international model, from the staff and villagers who pioneered this transforming experience, and transform yourself and your understanding of primary health care.

The course can be taken as short course or for academic credit with assessment; it is an elective subject within the Master of Public Health program of the University of Melbourne.

## Course Dates

Two 3-week courses will be offered:

Course 1: 22 November - 12 December 2009

Course 2: 10 - 30 January 2010

**Cost** - AUD 2050, includes tuition, accommodation and meals for the 3 weeks at Jamkhed.\*
